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Good afternoon,

As everyone is aware, the Bridgewater Township Electrical Inspector has refused to approve the electrical permit that has been filed by Sal Electric until he receives signed and sealed PE drawings. An approved electrical permit is legally required to start electrical work on your auditorium upgrades. Although a request for PE drawings for a project that is not new construction or major renovation is rare, it is still within the Electrical Inspector's authority to make such a request.

Our team understands that engineering costs are not only expensive but time-consuming, so we have worked diligently to update your submittal package to now include engineering drawings which can be found on the updated Bridgewater Submittals Folder: [Final Submittals](#).
